For these EYPP children the gap has closed from on entry to exit, moving from 8% at age related or above to 31% and the number well below reducing from 69% to 39%

Speaking remains the lowest achieving area with physical as the highest but has increased from 2015-16

There was a higher level of progress for those children who accessed a funded 2 place and benefitted from EYPP funding with 50% achieving age related or above compared to those who only access with EYPP Funding.

Future Developments

- More targeted Blast sessions
- Review of home/school “Talking Challenges”
- Continue with enrichment activities as they provide an excellent opportunity to bring a different experience for the EYPP children leading to new vocabulary.
